



## The Story so far.....

The company is one of the top tyre manufacturers in India and is listed for more than two decades. The stock has been trading sideways between Nov'14 and May'Apr'17 before finally breaking out of the 29 month of congestion.

However the stock went back brief into sideways mode again between Aug'17-Jan'18 in the range of Rs.230-285 before clearing the resistance with volumes. We expect the stock to do well in the coming 9-12 months.

Presently, we believe that the stock has broken out of a "triple top resistance" by moving above the levels of Rs.290/- in late January 2018 and we believe that this is a beginning of an uptrend. We expect the stock price to appreciate significantly from current levels of Rs.290/-.

## What is changing?

The 1.2% x 5 Box PF, indicating strong signals of a trend reversal after trading sideways between Aug 2017 - Jan 2018. The recent breakout from the "*triple top resistance line*" is an indication of resumption of the uptrend which only reaffirms our faith in the stock.

The 29 month correction between Nov'14-Apr'17 from Rs.238/- to Rs.133/- is now turning out to be a shakeout given the multiple instances of yet another "*bear and bull traps*" observed on charts at lower levels and now as prices show signs of sustaining above Rs.290/- levels we expect the stock to do well in the next 9 months or so.

## What is in store?

We applied "horizontal count method", to ascertain the probable target for the uptrend in the stock and based on that, we expect the stock to trade around Rs.389/- or above in the next 9 months or more.

The stock has delivered approximately 12.22% CAGR since 1994 on NSE and a return of 28.18% CAGR in the past 5 years. We expect the stock to continue its recent uptrend and it appears to be a good time initiate longs in APOLLOTYRE at current levels of Rs.290/-

A good way of accumulating the stock would be spread the purchases evenly between Rs.276-300 and keep a stop loss around Rs.254/- on a closing basis.
